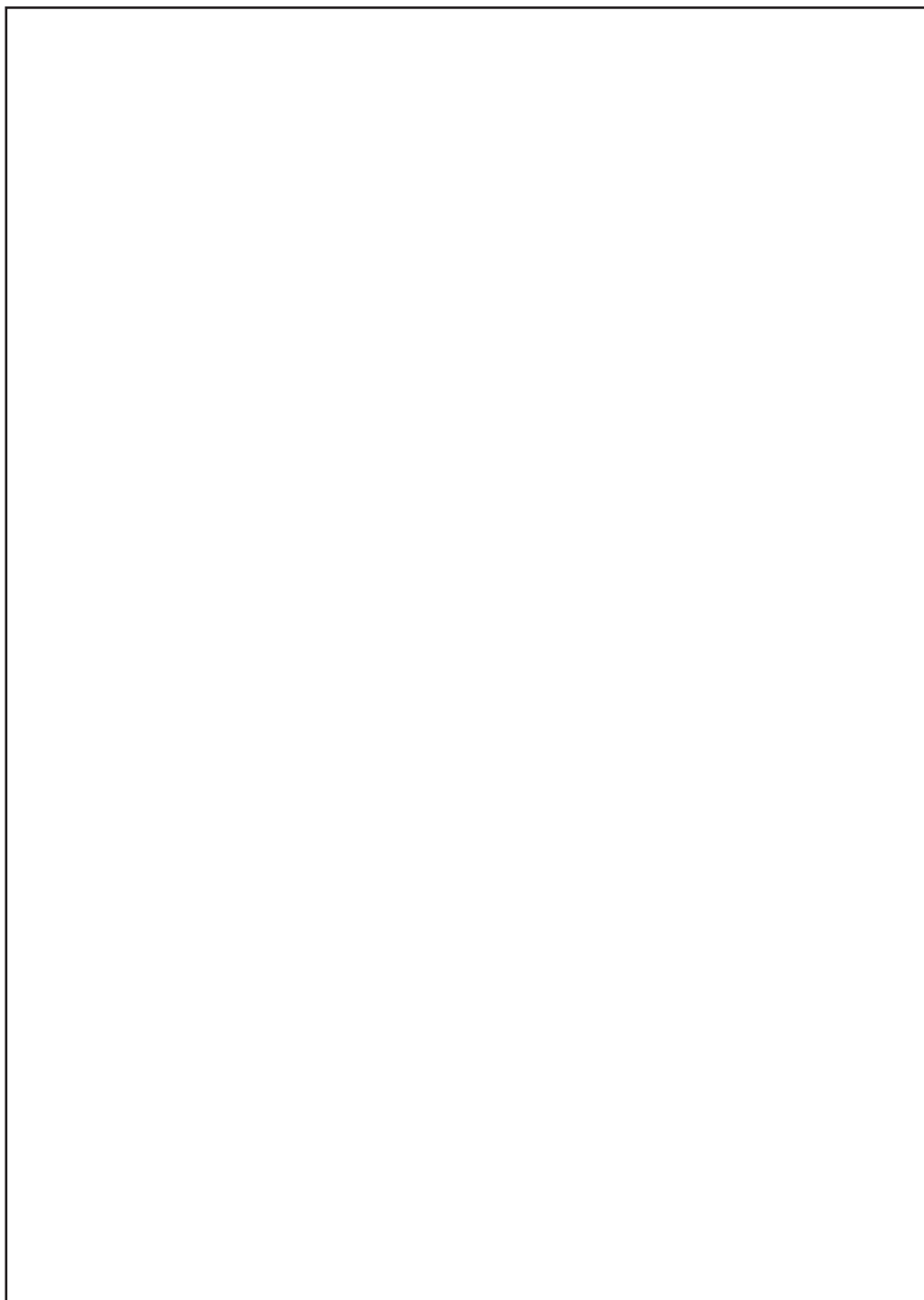


## Find the artist in you...
