

Ten in the Bed

(As first verse.)

(The same actions continue with each verse, and the row of children sitting alongside the bed grows, until the last verse.)

There was one in the bed and the little one said, 'Good night, good night'.

(The little one sits up, alone in the bed, says, 'Good night, good night', yawns, lies down and pretends to go to sleep in the middle of the bed.)
