
England

Is England the same as Britain?

• No. England, Scotland and Wales are all countries in Britain. Britain is the largest island in Europe.

Is Britain the same as the UK?

- No. The UK is Britain and Northern Ireland.
- The UK is a member* of the European Union.

Is Queen Elizabeth the Queen of England?

• Yes, and more! She's the Queen of the whole of the UK. She lives in Buckingham Palace in England and she's got a home in Scotland.

What is the Union flag?

The red St George's Cross of England, the red St Patrick's Cross of Ireland and the white St Andrew's Cross of Scotland on a blue background* make the Union flag.
