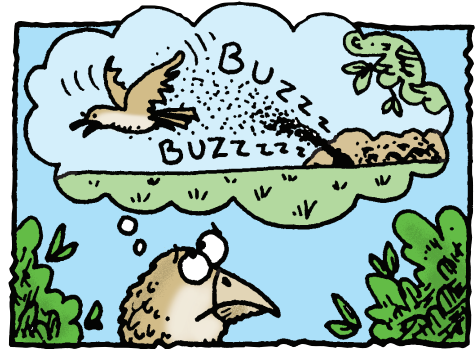
Feathered friends
