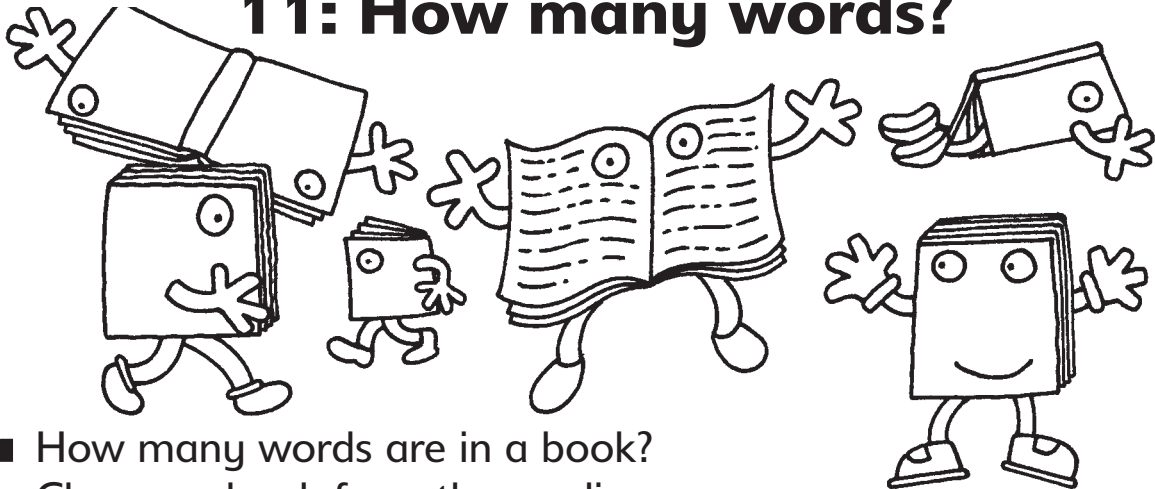


11: How many words?



- How many words are in a book?
- Choose a book from the reading corner.
- What sort of information do you need to know before trying to answer this question?
- Does it matter if it is a fiction or non-fiction book? What is the difference between them?
- What will help you to estimate the number of words?

12: Number bond suits

- Game for three or more players.
- Using playing cards, sort out cards 1–10 (using the Ace as 1) in a pack and shuffle them.
- One player is the Bond Checker; the others play the game until all the cards are won. Take turns in being the Bond Checker.
- The Bond Checker turns over the first card. The first person to call out its bond to 10 (for example, if a 3 is laid down, a player must call out '7', as $3 + 7 = 10$). The Bond Checker checks the call and awards the card to the first person to call the correct answer.
- The winner is the player with the most cards.
- Now include Jack as 11, Queen as 12 and King as 13. Play the game again and find number bonds to 20.

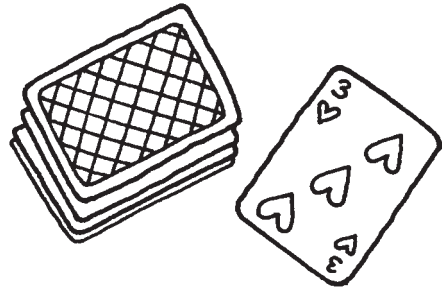
