You can also create a space, prehistoric or Egyptian time zone with our masks, perfect for creative class activities.







MASK INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Print out the templates and stick them onto thin card.
- 2. Colour in the mask pieces.
- 3. Cut out the pieces and circles for the eyes.4. Tie a piece of elastic around the back so that the mask fits around your head.

















Fancy dress


- 1. Print out the templates and stick them onto thin card.
- 2. Ask children to colour in the mask pieces.
- 3. Cut out the pieces and circles for the eyes.
- 4. Tie a piece of elastic around the back so that the mask fits on the child's head. Alternatively, stick the masks to a ruler or chopstick so that they can be held in front of the child's face.























MASK INSTRUCTIONS























DECORATIVE PHARAOH'S COLLAR

- 2. Stick the template on to thin card.
- 3. Cut around the outer edge and cut out the oval for the face.
- 4. Colour in the mask and tie a piece of elastic through the marked holes so that the mask fits.
