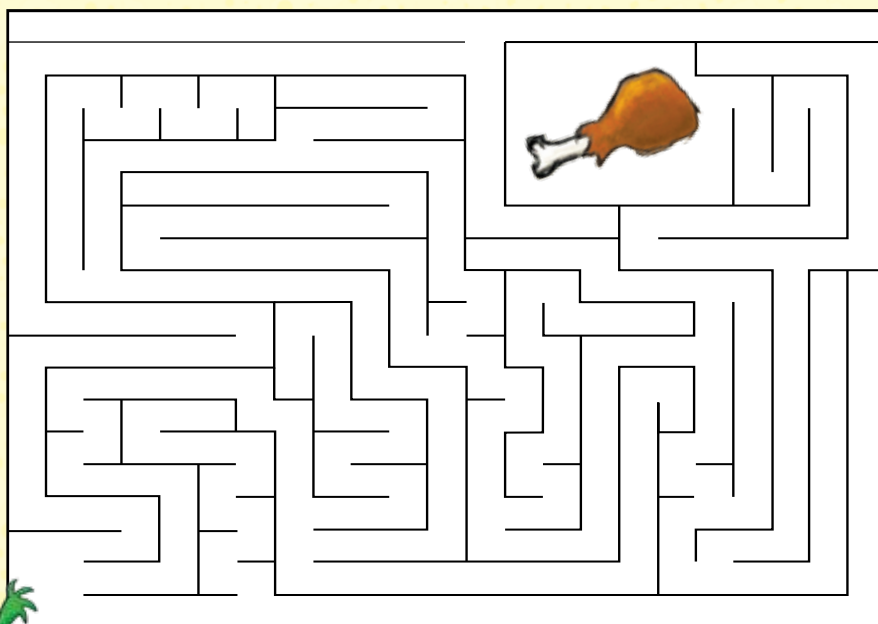
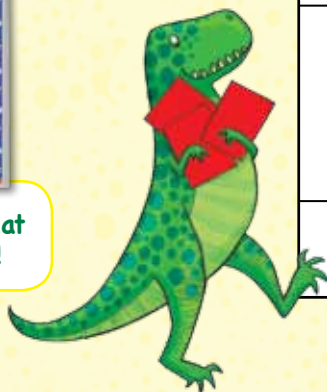

The fossil was named after Sue Hendrickson who found it in America - but no one knows if the T. Rex is a male or female!

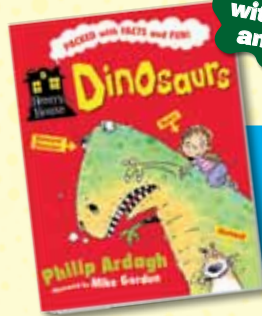
