A triceratops could be up to nine metres in length - that's twice as long as a car!



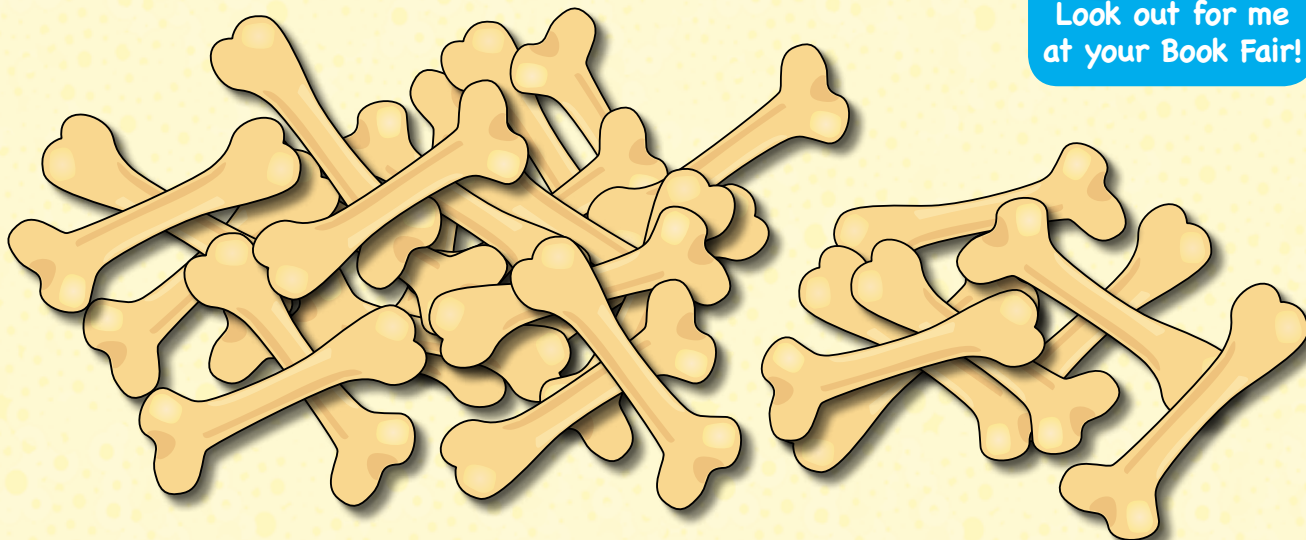
