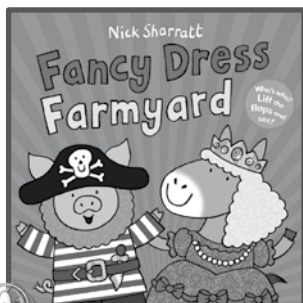
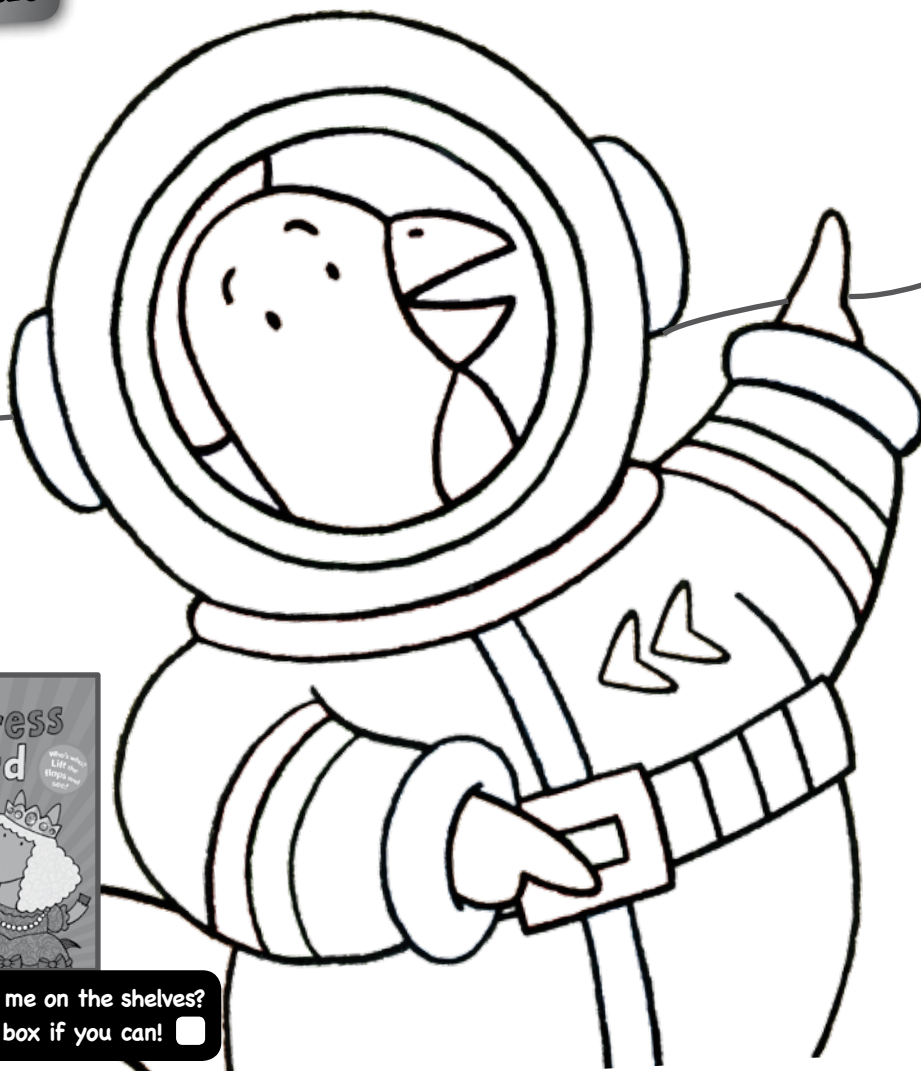
# ACTIVITY WISHLIST

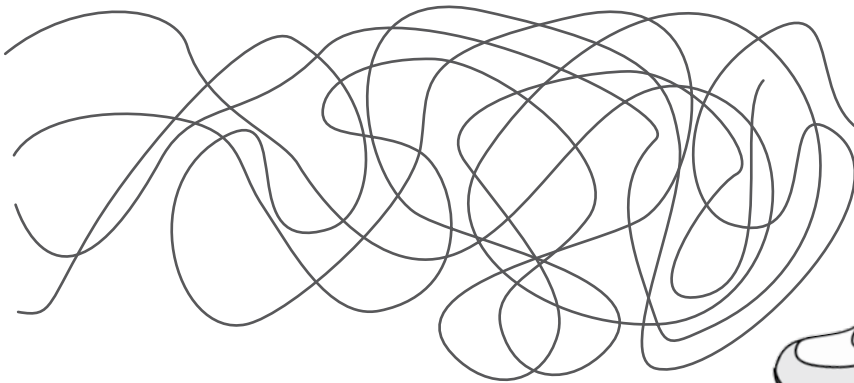
