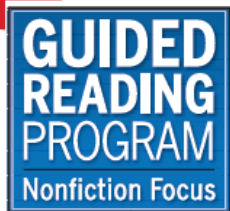


# Scholastic Guided Reading

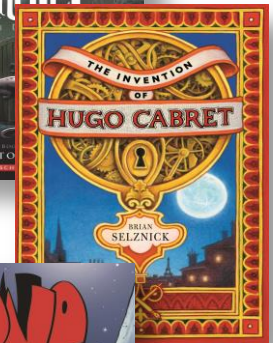

# Scholastic Guided Reading

## Grades K-6

- GR Nonfiction Focus: 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition is 80% nonfiction and 20% fiction
- GR Text Types is 80% fiction and 20% nonfiction
- GR Fiction Focus: 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition is 80% fiction and 20% nonfiction
- GR Content Areas is comprised of 45% science, 40% social studies, and 15% math titles
- **No title overlap between programs!**



# Scholastic Guided Reading

## Grades K-6

Guided Reading comprehensively meets the reading standards for literature. English conventions and grammar usage are routinely identified and discussed through a variety of reading, writing, and speaking activities.

### Key Ideas and Details

- Instructional features include: Making Connections; Developing Comprehension; Thinking Within; Beyond and About the Text; Oral Language/Conversation sections and writing exercises

### Craft and Structure

- With each library, teachers help students determine the meaning of words and phrases using strategies such as content clues in sentences, rereading, using sticky notes for future dictionary searches, referring to illustrations, and identifying word parts

### Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

- Teachers use many strategies to introduce a book, including discussion of illustrations and text

### Reading Range and Text Complexity

- Each library has been carefully leveled using a qualitative measure system factoring in reader variables such as vocabulary, language complexity, length of text and theme
- Each program is designed to help all students read increasingly complex text
