

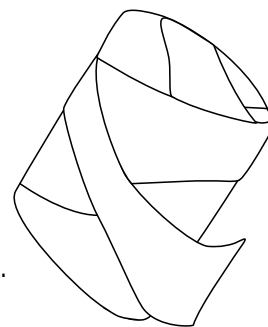
BOOK FAIR PYRAMID

Run this fun competition to get everyone wrapped up in reading!

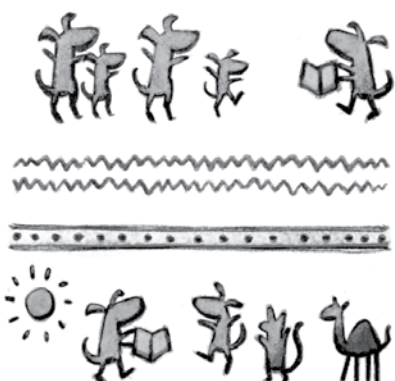
1. Choose a book from the Fair to be mummified!
2. Get some gauze or bandage material and give it an antique look by soaking in some water with a tea bag.
3. Once dry, wrap the book up until no details can be seen through the material.
4. Ask pupils to guess the number of pages in the mummified book.
The closest answer will win the book!

Use newspaper and scrap material to form a life-sized mummy, then cover with gauze or strips of cloth. Position in a chair (with a good book) to watch over the Book Fair Pyramid!



HIEROGLYPHICS

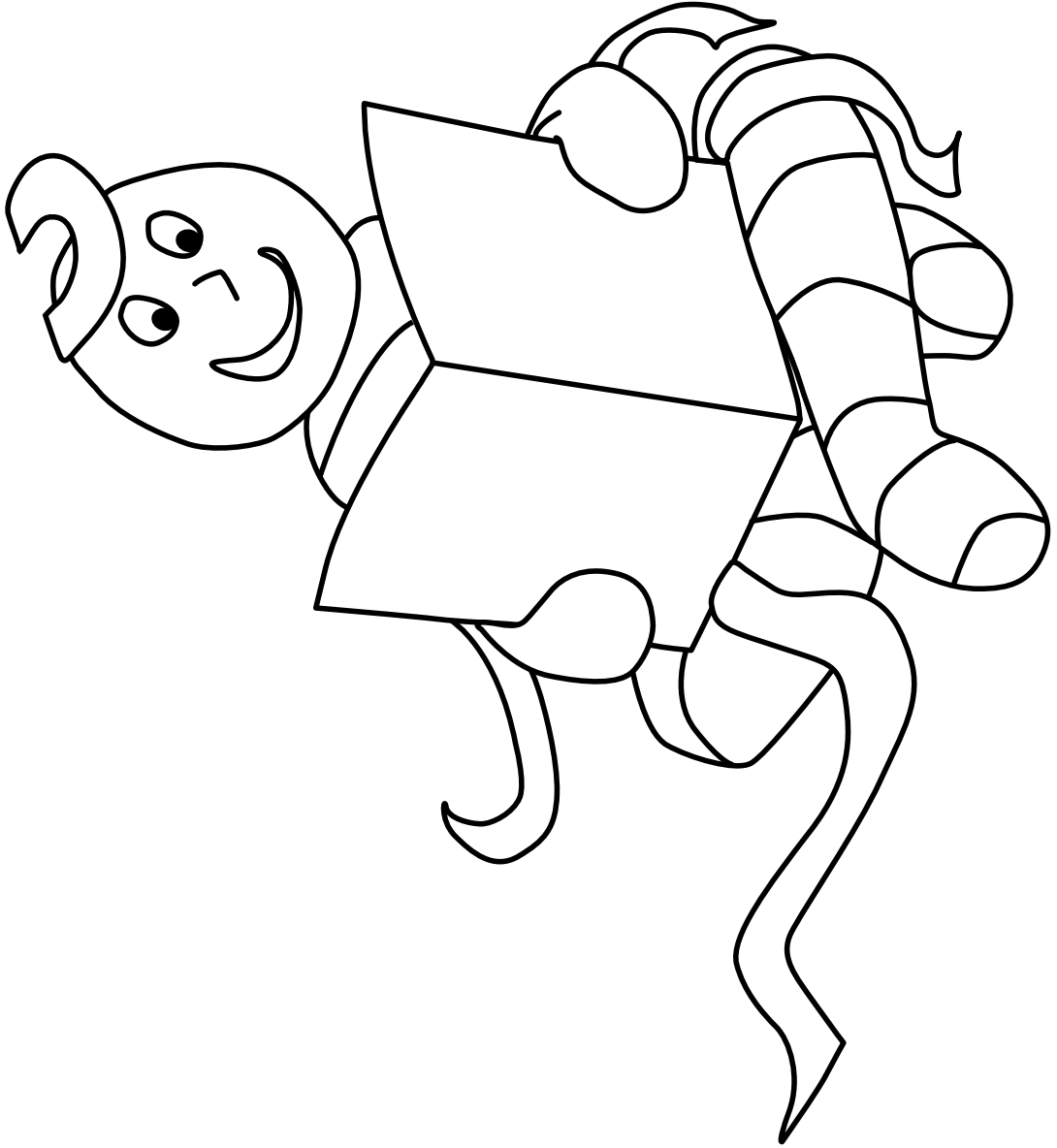

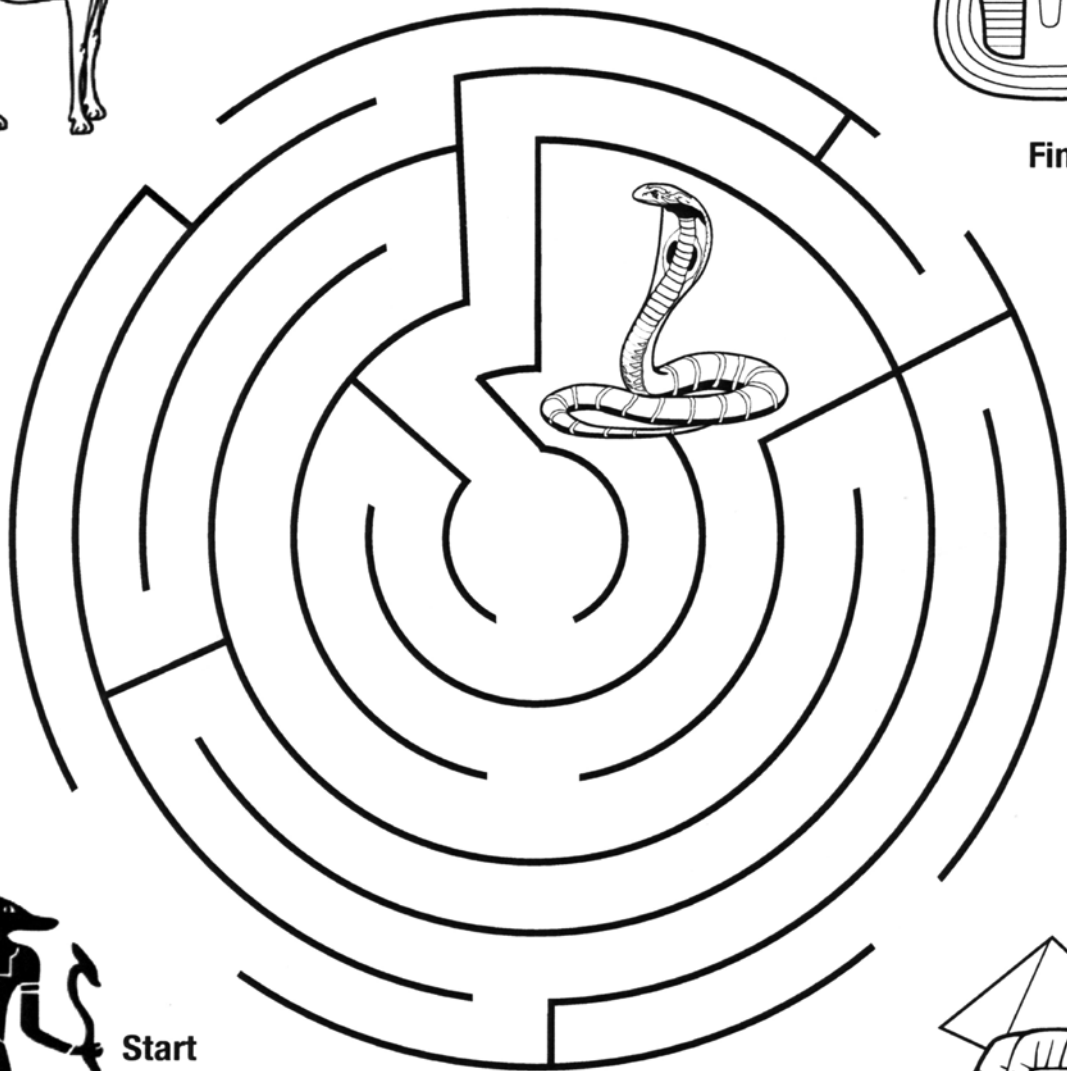


SEARCH FOR THE MUMMY'S TOMB!
