
Toucan Glasses

Downloaded pattern for toucan glasses Child-size plastic glasses Hot glue gun Double sided tape Light blue construction paper Fluorescent orange poster board Yellow construction paper Black marker Hot glue gun Scissors Black marker

Directions


- 1. Use child-size plastic glasses (available at party stores) for base. Pop out lenses, if you choose.
- 2. Download pattern, print, and cut out.
- 3. Trace eye rings, eye feathers, and beak band on light blue construction paper and cut out. Cut out centers of eye rings.
- 4. Trace beak on to fluorescent orange poster board and cut out
- 5. Trace beak highlight onto yellow construction paper and cut out.
- 6. Tape beak highlight and beak band to beak with double-sided tape.
- 7. Color top of beak band and feather details with a black marker.
- 8. Hot glue beak to bottom rim of eyeglasses. Finally, hot glue feathers to the back of the top rim of eyeglasses.





Elephant Mask

Materials

Downloaded pattern for elephant headband Slate blue construction paper Double-sided tape Scissors Black marker

Directions

- 1. Cut a 3 ¼" (width) x 24" (length) band out of a large sheet of slate blue paper (available at art stores or art sections of craft stores).
- 2. Download pattern, print, and cut out.
- 3. Trace ears and trunk onto remaining paper. Draw ear and trunk details with black marker. Cut out 3 pieces.
- 4. Fit band around student's head and tape ends together with transparent tape. Attach ears to each side of band with double-sided tape.
- 5. Tape top of trunk underneath the front of band with double-sided tape.






Materials

Downloaded gorilla mask pattern Purple construction paper Orange construction paper Craft glue Dark orange marker Dark purple marker String Transparent tape

Directions

- 1. Download pattern, print, and cut out.
- 2. Tape pieces of Gorilla Hair pattern together, trace onto a large piece of purple construction paper, and cut out.
- 3. Trace eyebrows, nostrils, and chin onto purple paper and cut out.
- 4. Trace face and ears onto large piece of orange construction paper and cut out. Cut out eyeholes.
- 5. Using multi-purpose or craft glue, adhere eyebrows, nostrils, and chin to face.
- 6. Tape face to hair with double-sided tape. Next, tape ears to side of head. Add mouth and ear details with dark orange marker. Draw highlights on hair with dark purple marker.
- 7. Using transparent tape, tape 2 pieces of thin string to back of gorilla head, level with ears.
