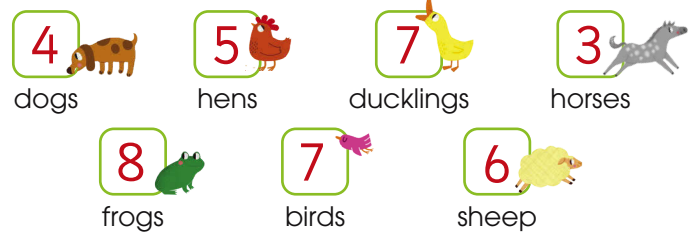


Counting Numbers 1-10

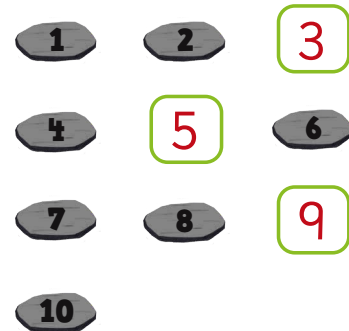

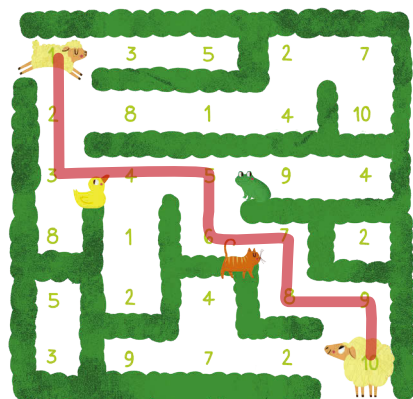

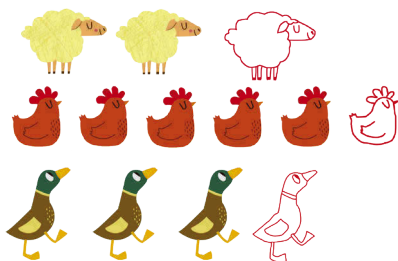
