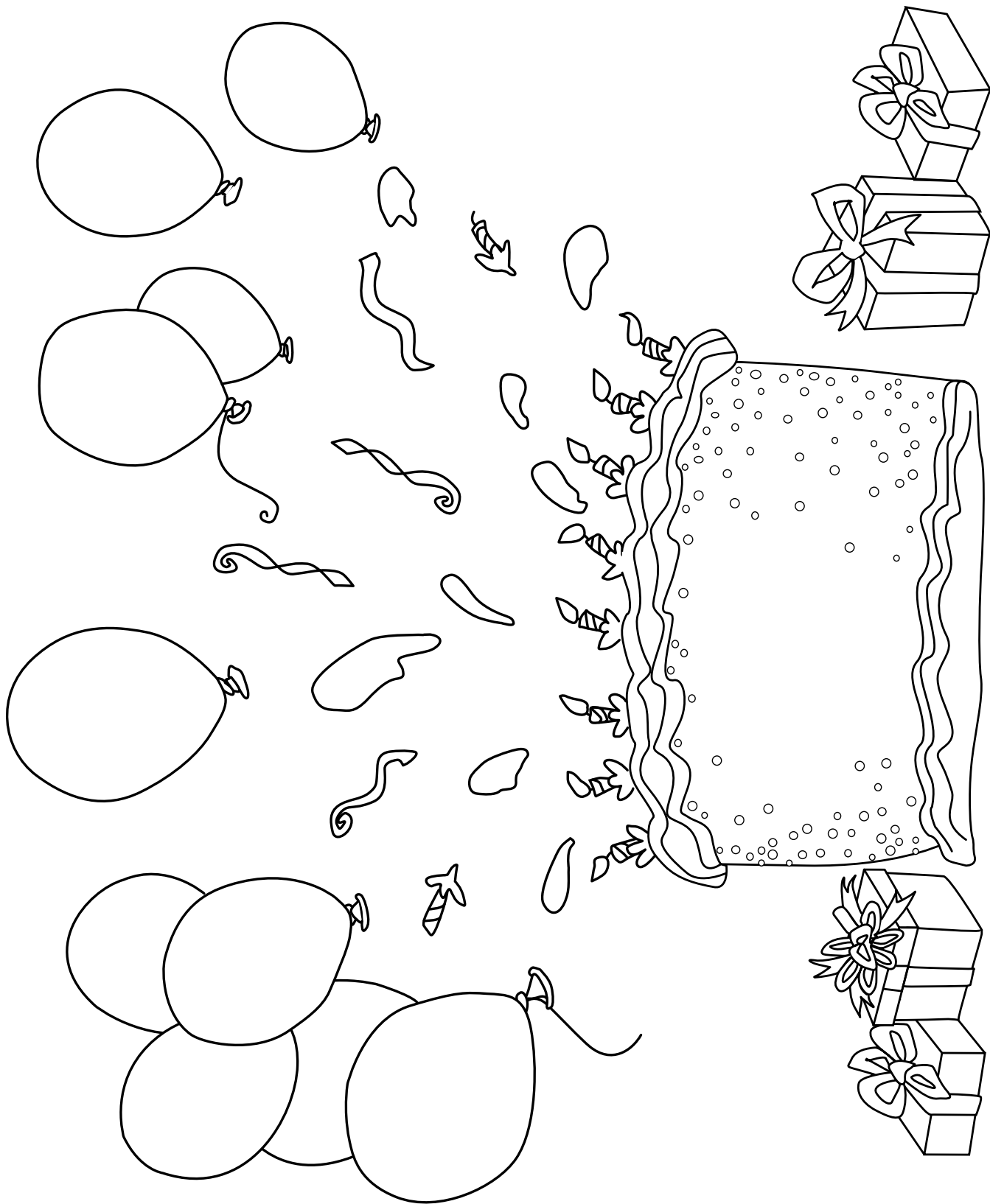
Streamers

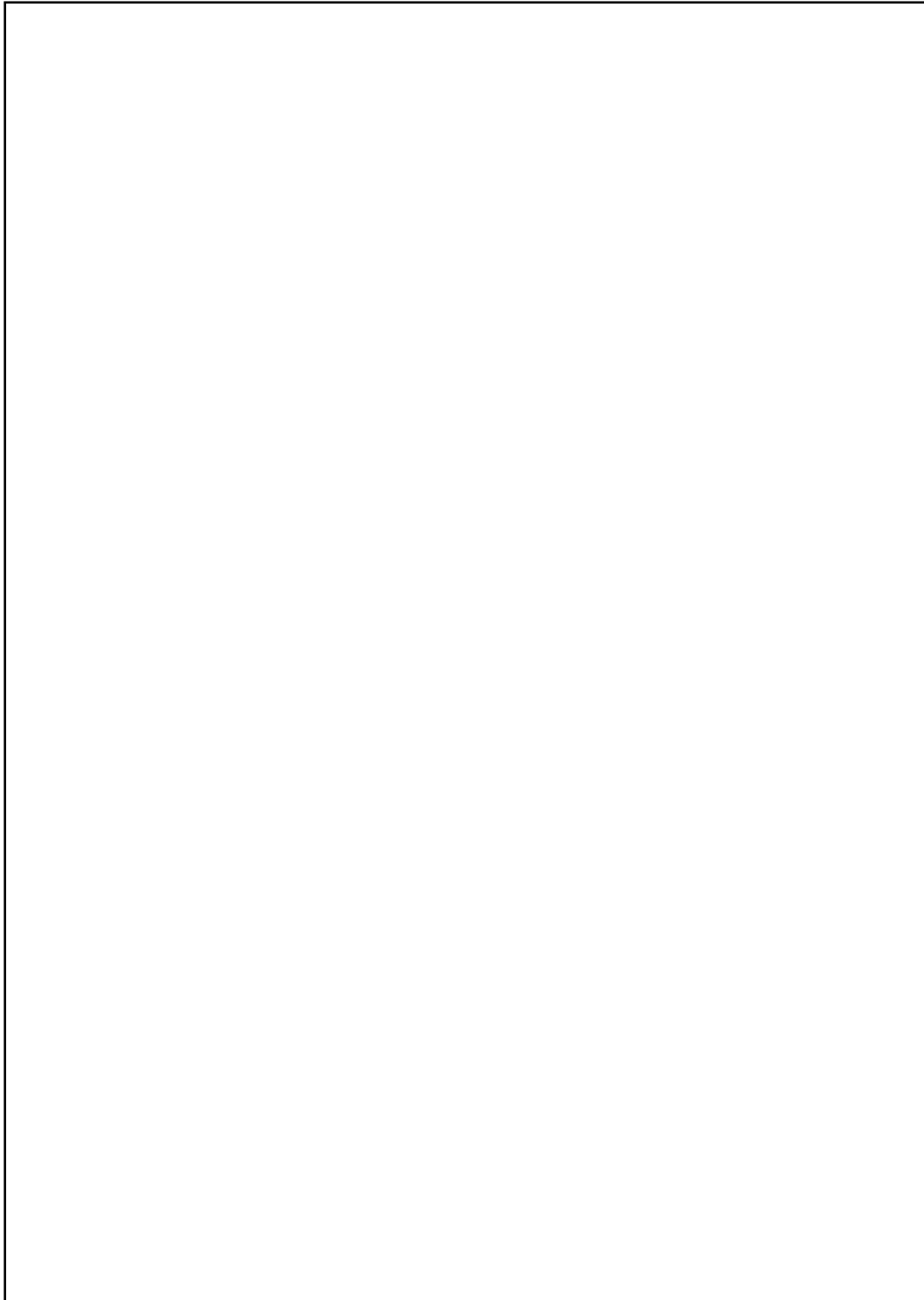
