Suffixes

Suffixes are word parts that are placed at the end of other words to change their meaning and parts of speech.

Example: *beauty* (noun) + *ful* becomes *beautiful* (adjective)

Common suffixes to make adjectives include: -less, -ful, -ous, -able, -ible

Common suffixes to make nouns include: -ment, -hood, -ness, -ation, -ship, -ism
