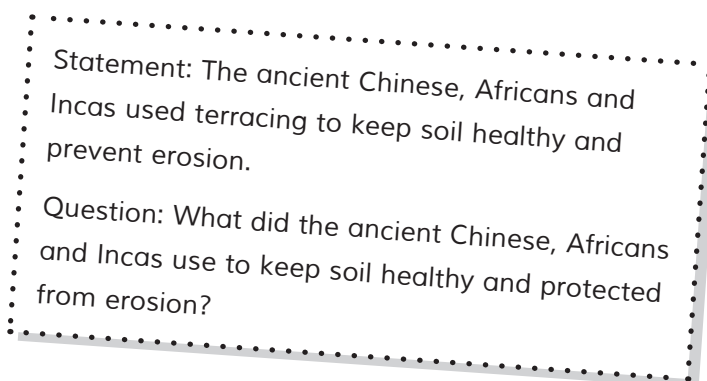
Answer: Burning of fossil fuels such as oil, coal and petrol causes air pollution.
