These books are a blast to read and they can help bring out your creative side too. If you love drawing, use the wide variety of art styles here to inspire you - every story has a different look.

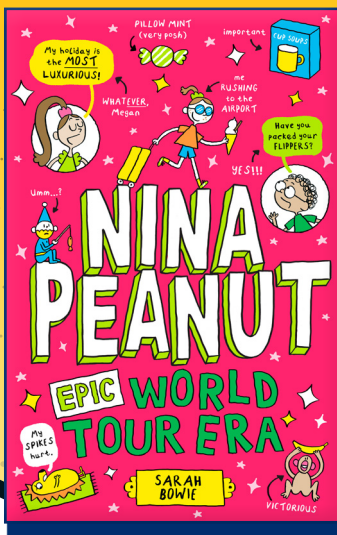
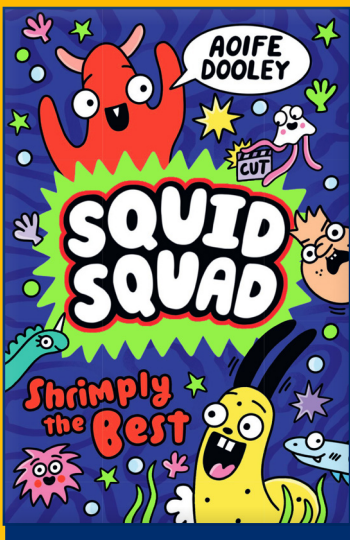

Q&A WITH DAVID SAYLOR

Senior Vice & Creative President
of Graphix



Why do you think graphic novels are so powerful at getting children reading, especially those who might struggle with traditional books?

Words and images together are a very powerful combination. In the same way that picture books engage very young children, graphic novels and comics immediately draw in readers with action, emotion, and conversations. Seeing the expressions on the characters, their body language, and the context of the conversations can give excellent readers—and struggling readers—the exciting entry points into a story. As Lewis Carroll wrote, “And what is the use of a book,” thought Alice, “without pictures or conversations?” Graphic novels have both!

How do you see the role of graphic novels evolving in the next 20 years? Will they become even more important in school reading and libraries?

I feel very enthusiastic about how graphic novels are being embraced by readers, parents, and booksellers. I expect that they will continue to become a major part of the publishing sphere for the coming years, expanding further into nonfiction and other book categories. And the overlap between manga readers and graphic novel readers will blend and blur into a very exciting future.

Q&A WITH DAVID SAYLOR

Senior Vice & Creative President of Graphix

How can teachers use graphic novels to build a reading-for-pleasure culture in the classroom?

Graphic novels absolutely offer a reading-for-pleasure moment in classrooms. And they lend themselves easily to lessons on character development, how the art helps offer context clues to the narrative, and reading comprehension. Teachers are always the first ones to embrace ways to get students excited about reading and graphic novels are the perfect tool.

What would you say to a child who thinks reading is boring – might a graphic novel change their mind?

My answer to that is Dav Pilkey and Dog Man! I've rarely seen kids get as excited and enthusiastic about books as when they read Dog Man, which is full of heart and humor in abundance. And truthfully, there's a graphic novel for every kid. There are graphic novels on every topic and in every genre. So I say, YES, the right graphic novel (like the right book for the right reader) will change anyone's mind about reading being "boring."

When you first launched Graphix, there wasn't much shelf space for graphic novels for kids. What changed over the past 20 years to make them so central to children's reading today?

The major change that happened is that graphic novels offered a longer and richer reading experience to children. Many children love comics and newspaper cartoons, but back in 2005 there wasn't much out there with longer adventures and stories for children. Now there are shelves of wonderful graphic novels that offer rich, dramatic, engaging, long-form storytelling that feels completely satisfying. We just had to create the books. I knew the audience would find and embrace them, because I loved comics as a kid, and I wanted longer books that I could read again and again. And here we are!

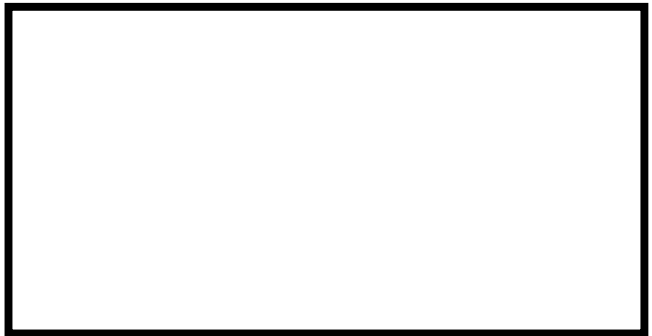

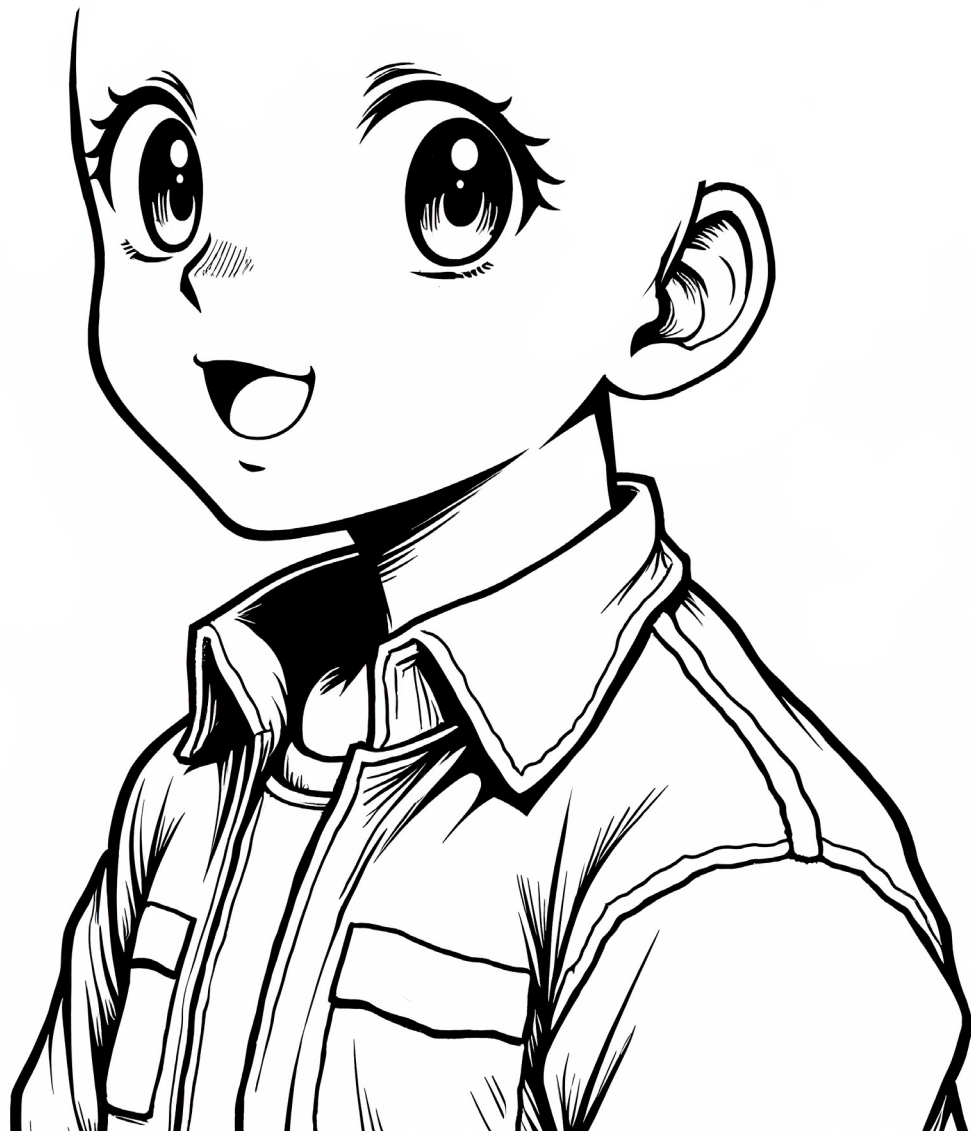

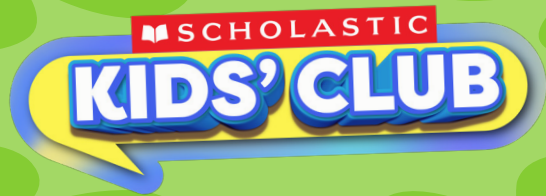
