



Teacher Added Points



In Scholastic Reading Pro teachers may assign points for an activity other than passing a book quiz. For example, you might want to give the student credit for presenting a book report to the class.

How to add points:

In Reading Pro, find the student using the search bar or expandable class list.


Please note that adding an activity will not change a student's (or class) word count. Only by passing quizzes in Reading Pro will the word count increase.

How many points should be added?

The book quiz points are based on the word count and the lexile level. Please see the table at the end of this guide for more details.

For example, there are 76,944 words in *Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone* by JK Rowling and the lexile level of this book is 880L, meaning there are 13 points awarded for passing this book quiz.

If a child has read a book which does not have a quiz in Reading Pro and you are able to find out the word count (try searching on the internet for the word count) and lexile level (try <https://hub.lexile.com/find-a-book/search>) you can add the exact number of points for the activity.

Alternatively, search for a book on Reading Pro that you know is similar in terms of difficulty and length, and then assign the same number of points as that book.
