


Make Your Own Dragon's Mask

Instructions for Young Dragons:

- 1. If your dragon's mask is a black and white one, colour it in.
- 2. Carefully cut out the face and the nose of the dragon's mask. Don't cut out the eye-holes, as the face of the dragon is supposed to sit on your forehead.
- 3. Ask an adult to punch the holes on the sides of the mask for the elastic.
- 4. To put the two parts together you need to fold the tabs on the dragon's nose up at the dotted line and secure them behind the face with sticky tape.
- 5. Don't forget to fold the tip of the dragon's nose into the small tabs and secure it with sticky tape as well.
- 6. Ask for help to attach a length of elastic to each side so that the elastic reaches around your head.

Now you are a ferocious dragon!





Dragon's tail


Instructions for helpers/teachers

- 1. Glue the two parts of the dragon's tail onto thin cardboard and cut them out.
- 2. Stick the two parts together with sticky tape.
- 3. Use the template of the dragon's scale to cut several of these out of green cellophane and glue them on the top of the tail overlapping each other.










Dragon's Suit

Instructions for helpers/teachers

- 1. Measure your child from feet to shoulder and buy a piece of green fabric twice as long. The piece of fabric should be about 20cm wider than your child's shoulders. Fold the fabric in half widthways and make a hole for the head at the fold.
- 2. On the reverse, sew both sides, leaving two slits for the arms.
- 3. If you want to add scales to the suit take some green cellophane, cut it into scale shapes and glue them on the fabric, overlapping each other.
- 4. If you want to add the dragon's tail available at link, make a horizontal 12cm cut on the back of the suit so you are able to put the tail through it. Remember to buy an extra piece of fabric for the tail!










Make Your Own Knight's Helmet Mask

- 1. Stick your helmet onto thin cardboard.
- 2. Ask an adult to cut out your mask including the eye-holes and make two small cuts for the elastic to go through each side of your mask.
- 3. Stick the crest on the top of the mask.
- 4.Ask for help to attach a length of elastic to each side so that the elastic reaches around your head. Now you are a real knight!










Make Your King's Crown

- 1. Glue your crown onto a thin cardboard and ask an adult to cut it out.
- 2. Ask for help to adjust the crown to the size of your head.
- 3. Glue the edges, let it dry for a while and then put it on your head. Now you're a real king!



Knight's Tunic

Instructions for helpers/teachers

- 1. Measure your child from knees to shoulder and buy a piece of light brown fabric twice as long. The piece of fabric should be about 40cm wider than your child's shoulders.
- 2. Cut another piece of fabric the same length and 10cm wide.
- 3. Fold the fabric into two and make a round hole for the head at the fold. On the bottom, cut the fabric in the form of semicircles.
- 4. Put the fabric over your child's head, overlap the front and back and use the 10cm wide stripe of fabric to tie around your child's waist. Finish with a knot at the back.

And an enchanted knight comes alive!






FIGURE 1. FIGURE 2.










Make your own Princess Hat

- 1) Carefully cut out the shapes on the following pages. The arrows will make the ribbons, and the funny curve shape will make the cone!
- 2) On the cone of your hat, there's a little white mark. This white mark will be right at the top of the point of your hat. Make a really small fold on this line and turn the piece of paper over.
- 3) Cut two pieces of sticky tape about 8cm long.
- 4) Start to roll the cone around the point where you made the fold. Roll it all the way around until you've got a cone.
- 5) Now you've rolled your cone, you'll see that you've got two corners. Overlap these corners by about 1cm and tape at the bottom. Follow the line the hat and about half way up, stick the other piece of tape.



6) Snip a small hole right at the top of your cone. Tape the two arrows together, the smaller one on top. Insert the point of the ribbons into the small slice you've just made at the top of the cone and secure them with sticky tape. Now you're ready to be a princess!









Make Your Own Shield

- 1. Carefully cut out the two halves of your shield, overlap them and put some sticky tape on the reverse to keep the two parts together.
- 2. To make it sturdier you can stick it on a cardboard.
- 3. Cut out the handles and stick them on the back of your shield. If you prefer, use a piece of cardboard to stick a handle on the back.











Make Your Own Knight's Sword

- 1. Carefully cut out both sides of the sword.
- 2. Glue one of the sides onto cardboard to make it sturdy and then cut out the cardboard in the same shape as the sword.
- 3. Glue the second part of sword on the other side of the cardboard.

Now you are a true knight!










Make Your Own Princess Tiara

- 1. Glue your tiara onto a thin cardboard and ask an adult to cut it out. Put some glitter on it if you like.
- 2. Ask for help to adjust the tiara to the size of your head.
- 3. Glue the edges, let it dry for a while and then put it on your head. Now you're a real princess!












- 1. Cut out the rectangle and roll it tight. Secure the edges with sticky tape.
- 2. Ask an adult to help you make two cuts on the top of the wand.
- 3. Cut out the two sides of the ruby and glue them together.
- 4. Slot the ruby on the top of the wand.



























Make your own Wizard's Hat

1) Carefully cut out the shapes on the following pages. The circle will make the rim of your hat, and the funny shape with the moons and stars will make the cone!

Be careful not to cut the white tabs off the rim or you won't look like a proper wizard!

- 2) On the cone of your hat, there's a little white mark. This white mark will be right at the top of the point of your hat. Make a really small fold on this line and turn the piece of paper over.
- 3) Cut two pieces of sticky tape about 8cm long.
- 4) Start to roll the cone around the point where you made the fold. Roll it all the way around until you've got a cone.
- 5) Now you've rolled your cone, you'll see that you've got two corners. Overlap these corners by about 1cm and tape at the bottom. Follow the line up the hat and about half way up, stick the other piece of tape.
- 6) Position the cone over the rim of the hat and place both holes above one another. Use the tabs and tape to secure both sections. Put the hat on your head and become a wizard!
