

Once there was a lighthouse keeper called Mr. Grinling.


At night time he lived in a small white cottage perched high on the cliffs, and in the daytime he rowed out to his lighthouse to clean and polish the light.

And although Josef, Isabel, and Mahmoud are separated by continents and decades, shocking connections will tie their stories together in the end.









If she tries really hard to be. Because there's something that makes Tally not the same as her friends. Something she can't cover up, no matter how hard she tries: Tally is autistic.


Tally's autism means there are things that bother her even though she wishes they didn't. It means that some people misunderstand, her and feel frustrated by her.
