In the early months of 2020, Tomfoolery (Tomos Roberts) started his online YouTube account striking a careful balance between spoken word poetry and storytelling with a calming, big-brotherly demeanour. It proved a successful formula; his poem, 2020's 'The Great Realisation', attracted over 100 million views and was shared by names such as Jake Gyllenhaal, Jennifer Anniston & Khloe Kardashian. The poem went on to underscore Ashley Banjo and Diversity's Britain's Got Talent dance, which won the BAFTA Award for Must-See Moment 2021, as well as the national midnight moment of London's 2020/2021 NYE firework display. Tomos went on to perform *Alive with Popp*ies at 2021's Royal British Legion Festival of Remembrance.
