This report is based on pay data as at 5th April 2020 and bonus data in year up to 5th April 2020.

Equal Pay and Bonus Pay Gap

Women's hourly rate is 2.43% (median) higher then men.

Women's hourly rate is 11.84% (mean) lower then men.

Women's bonus pay is 226.64% (median) higher than men.

Women's bonus pay is 22.15% (mean) higher then men.

Since our 2019 report our median pay gap has reduced by 8.31% and our mean pay gap has increased by 1.73%.

2020 Bonus Pay








Since our 2019 report percentage of male workforce who received a bonus has increased by 10% and percentage of female workforce who received a bonus has increased by 11%.

For 2020 73% of bonuses were paid to women and 27% paid to men.


Gender Distribution










2019 Lower Middle Quartile
