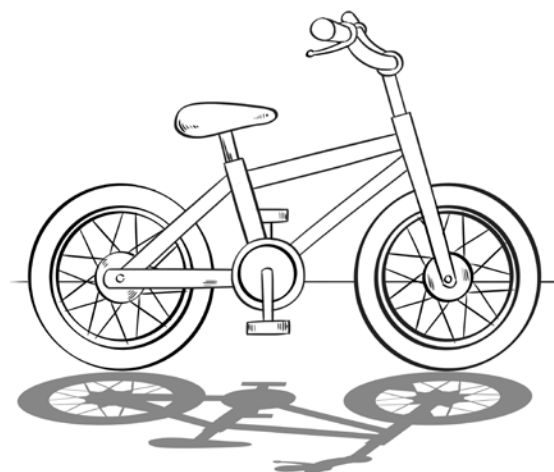

Number these steps in the procedure to put them in the correct order.

Choose a piece of chalk. Carefully trace around the edge of the shadow.	
Colour in the shape. Spread the colour around by smudging the chalk.	
Once you are happy with your tracing, remove the object so you can see your outline without the shadow.	
Stand back and look at your work. Have you outlined everything?	
Sign your work.	
Look for a concrete path or area in the sunshine.	
Add highlights and shadows by smudging white and coloured chalk over some areas.	
Place your object on the concrete so that it casts a shadow where you want to draw.
