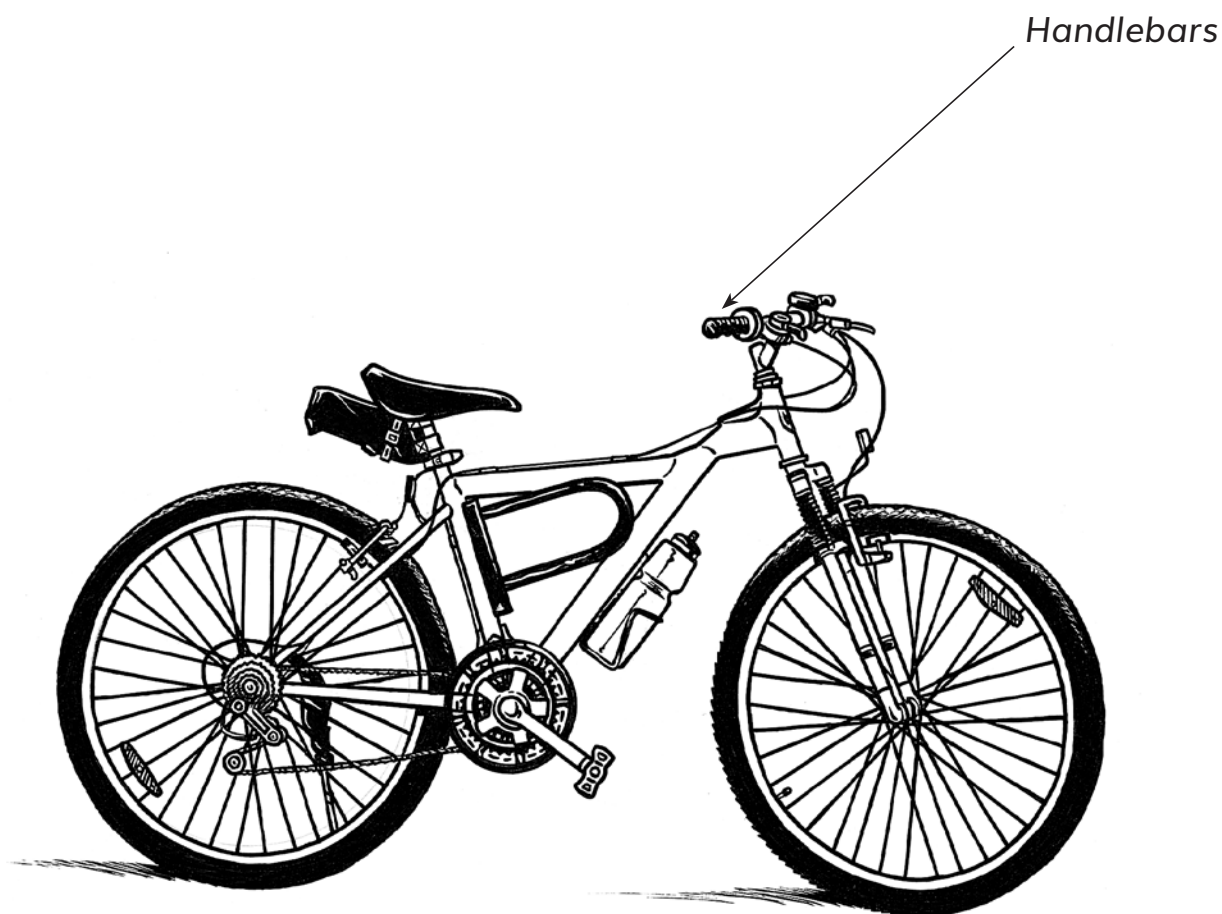

	Put the new tube inside the tyre.
	Pull out the inner tube.
	Pump up the tyre.
	Tuck the tyre back inside the wheel rim.
	Pinch the tyre walls together to separate the tyre from the wheel rim.
1	<u>Unscrew</u> the valve cap.
	Push the valve back through the hole in the rim.
	Push the valve to deflate the tyre.
	Unhook one side of the tyre from the wheel.
