1. Tell everyone



The key to a successful Book Fair is making sure children, parents and grandparents come. Get everyone exploring the bookcases and your Fair will flourish!

- Send the invitations home to parents. You'll find ready-made invitations in your **Big Red Box**. Send them home with a letter a week or so before your Fair to give parents and children a taster of what's to come.
- Put up the posters around your school. Make sure everyone knows where and when your Fair will be held. Use the posters in your Big Red Box or get pupils to make more.
- Hold special assemblies and reading events. Build up anticipation by counting down the days until the Fair arrives in assembly or class. Get children thinking about their favourite books by reading extracts and holding book discussions our book talk notes can be found online.
- **Recruit volunteers to help.** Ask pupils, parents and school staff to lend a hand running the Fair. Many hands make light work!



We made sure that parents knew what an exciting time the children were going to have by sending home an advance letter outlining all the events and competitions. Children were also involved in publicity by designing and making posters.

2. Make it a special event



Attract pupils and parents with an eye-catching Book Fair! From decorations to displays, there are lots of fun ways to get everyone involved!

- **Put up the banner and arrows.** We aim to send a reusable banner with every Fair. Put it up outside the school so everyone knows that the Fair is on!
- Open up your bookcases. Don't forget to pull up the boards on the back for an instant display. Why not showcase some favourite books on top of each case too?
- **Decorate your Book Fair.** It's time to get creative! Balloons, ribbons, artwork and book displays will all help to bring your Fair to life.
- **Hold a fancy dress day.** Use our theme to have a fun, fancy dress day, or choose your own theme such as favourite children's book characters.

3. Explore the books

The more your pupils browse the books and delve into the stories, the more likely they are to find the perfect one for them!

- Arrange class-by-class browsing. Organise a quiet time for children to explore the books during the school day about 20 minutes per class is best and ask them to make a wishlist of the books they most want to read. You'll find stickers to reward little explorers in your Big Red Box.
- Run a competition with books as prizes. Whether it's designing a book cover, writing a book review or dressing up, children love competitions. Register online for £25 worth of free book vouchers to use as prizes.
- Use the book-themed activity sheets. Full of fun puzzles, the activity sheets are perfect for engaging children with the books on the Fair. You'll find them in your Big Red Box.

4. Pack up and pay
