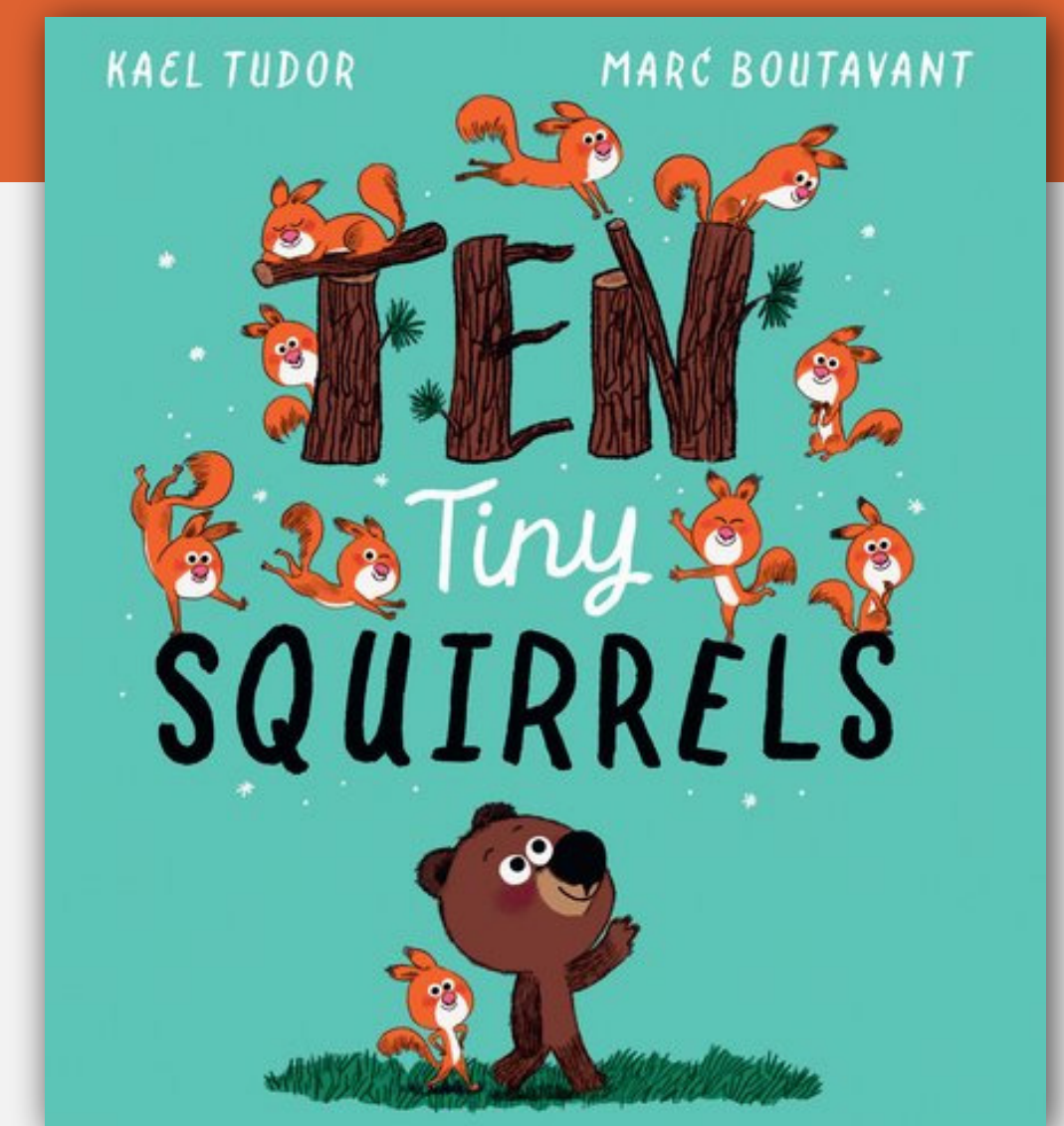


STORY SNAPSHOT
