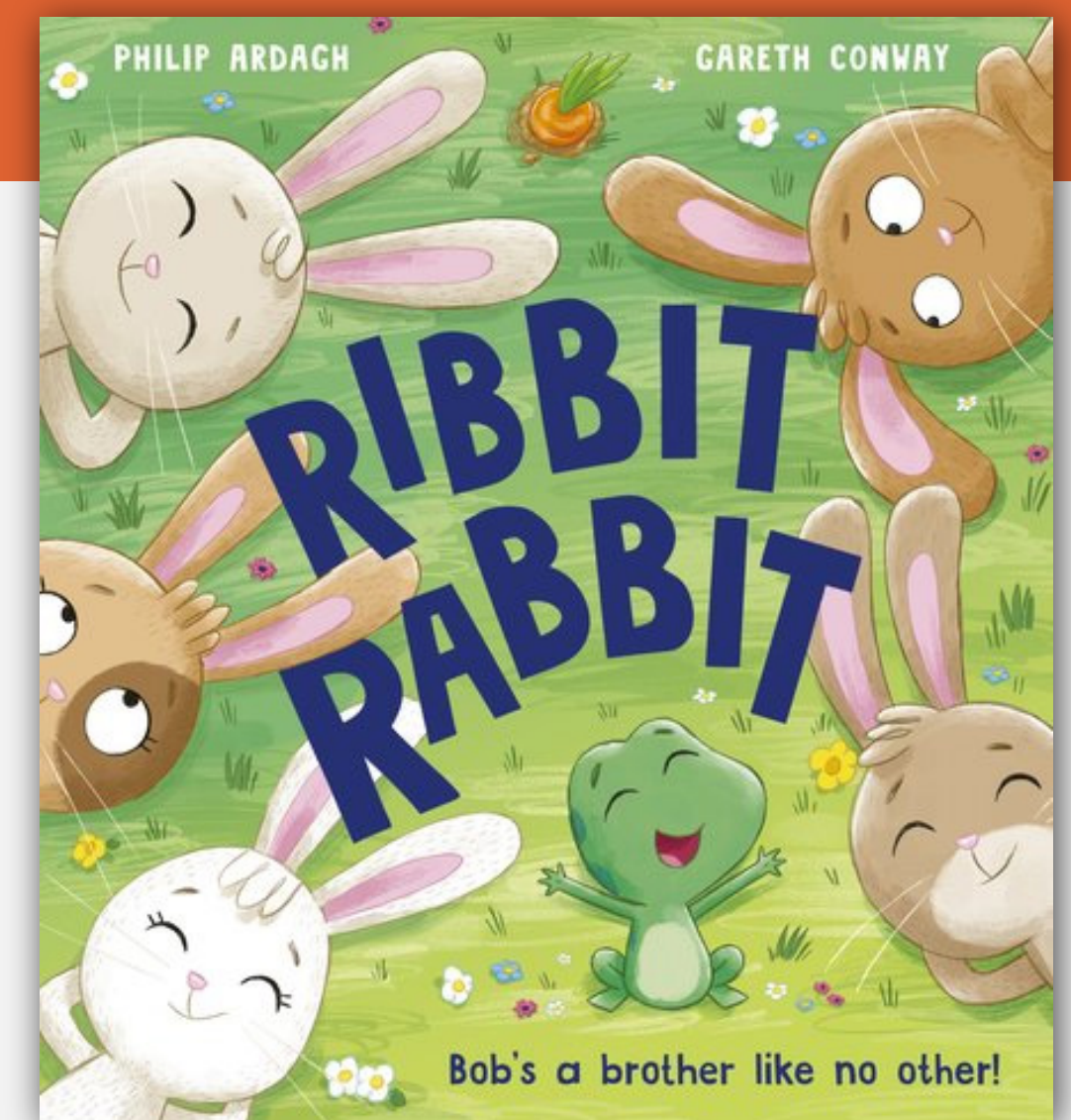


**STORY SNAPSHOT**
