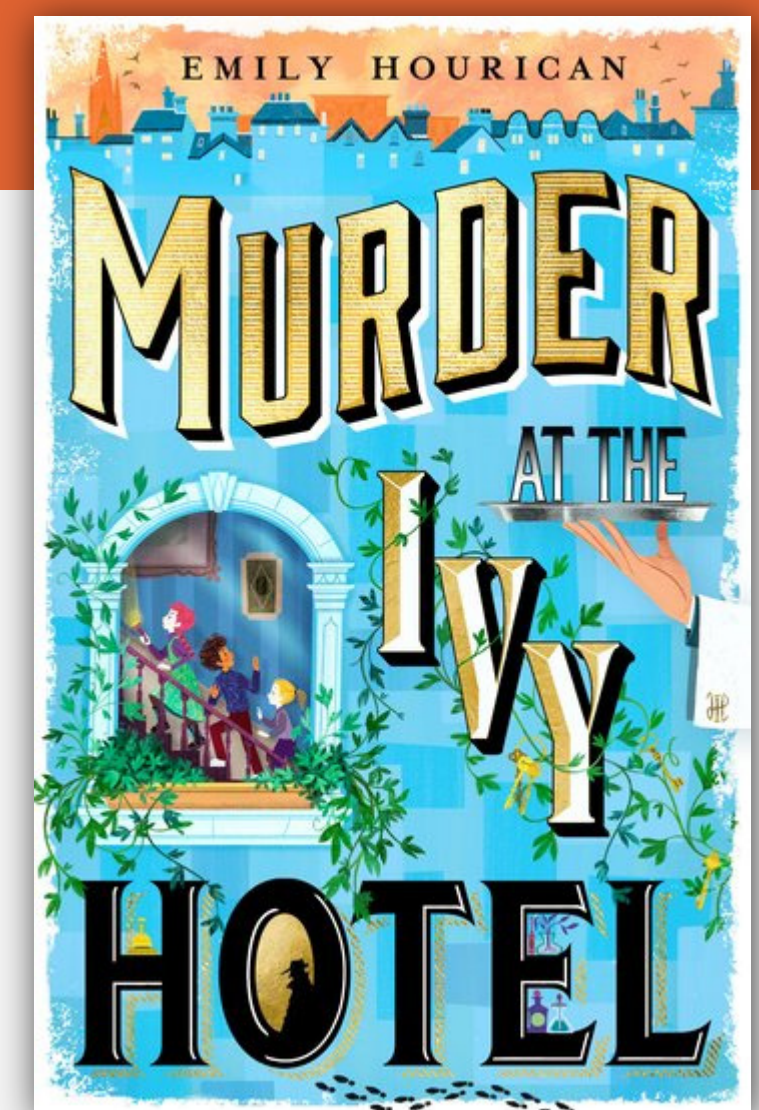


STORY SNAPSHOT
