Study **Figure 1**, a 1: 50 000 Ordnance Survey map extract of part of the area around Hurst Castle in Hampshire.

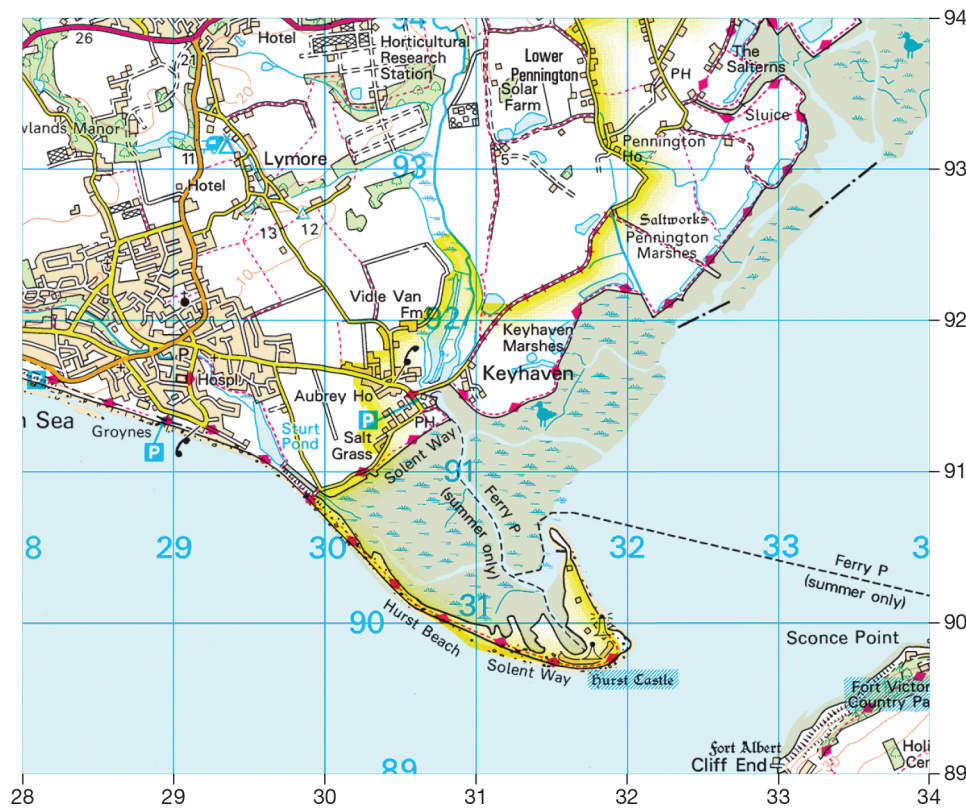
